


TIPS

- 1) To start with your base cabinets, to help keep organized and easier to make sure you did not miss anything. Start either on the right or left of your kitchen layout, mark (1) on it, add it to the bag, continue 2, 3, 4...

Once all your base cabinets are selected, move on to the wall cabinets followed by your last number from the base cabinets. If you have a pantry or oven cabinet note they take 2-separate cabinets, example if your wall cabinets are 36" high your top pantry will be 36" high. The bottom will state bottom and be 54" high. Once you select all your cabinets do your fills toe kick next, then fillers if needed, then base end panels, then wall end panels only for the exposed sides.

If you have a pantry you will need a side panel for each exposed side, I normally select the 25" x 96", but to save a few dollars you can order the 48"W x 96"L x 1/4"D these though are only used if you purchased the framed cabinets if you selected frameless cabinet then you will need the 25"W x 96"L x 3/4"D, if you have an Island you can either use a 4x8 sheet or use 3/4" base end panels. You then may want scribe mold, crown or other items. You also may want the lazy-susan turn tables for your CB33 or CB36 base corner cabinet or roll out trays for your pantry. You will see  [Search Product](#) bottom left of the page to help find faster your panel, scribe mold, fillers etc. but always make sure you stayed on your color choice to be safe. Our standard wall cabinet are 30", 36", and 40" high, there are only 2-shelves that come with them. You can add extra shelves if you like, I prefer 3-shelves in the 36" & 40" high wall cabinets.

- 2) You can only add 1-cabinet size at a time.
- 3) Click [Add to Bag](#), automatically you are sent to the shopping cart where you can change the quantity if need more of that size.
- 4) Click on [continue shopping](#) you will be directed back to where you select different cabinets, you will still be in your cabinet color you started with.
